

Accessibility Enhancements at Festival of Trees

In an effort to make Kennedy Krieger Institute's Festival of Trees more accessible to the children and families we serve we have made the following changes to this year's event:

- 1) We have **handicap accessible restrooms** in SantaLand. *These facilities can be accessed to the right when you walk in SantaLand next to the other additional restrooms.*
- 2) We have a **"Calming Corral"** or sensory room. *This is an area for individuals who need to take a break from all the sights and sounds of Festival of Trees. The entrance to the Calming Corral is located in the back of SantaLand next to the Pony Rides.*
- 3) We have a **wheelchair accessible carousel** so that everyone can enjoy the festival fun!
- 4) We have **priority seating areas for individuals with disabilities**. *These areas will be located in the food court, arts & craft area, and the coloring & letter writing area.*
